

Pony Bead Keychains


You will need:

- Beads
- Cord

- Keychain
- Scissors


Instructions:


- Attach your cord to the keyring.
 Fold the cord in half, loop it through the keyring, and pull the ends through the loop. Tape the keychain to a surface to give yourself an anchor.
- String your first bead through one end, then the other
- Add two beads to one side of the cord
- Take the other side of the cord and thread it through those same beads. Pull tight.






















To make a leg, thread two beads onto one side of the cord. Then add three beads of a different color onto that same cord.




Thread that same cord back through the two "leg" beads only. Repeat these steps on the other side to create a second leg.



Once your legs are finished, keep going row by row through the body like you did in step 4.
Don't forget the second set of legs.



When you reach the end of the tail, tie a double knot to finish and cut off any extra cord.
